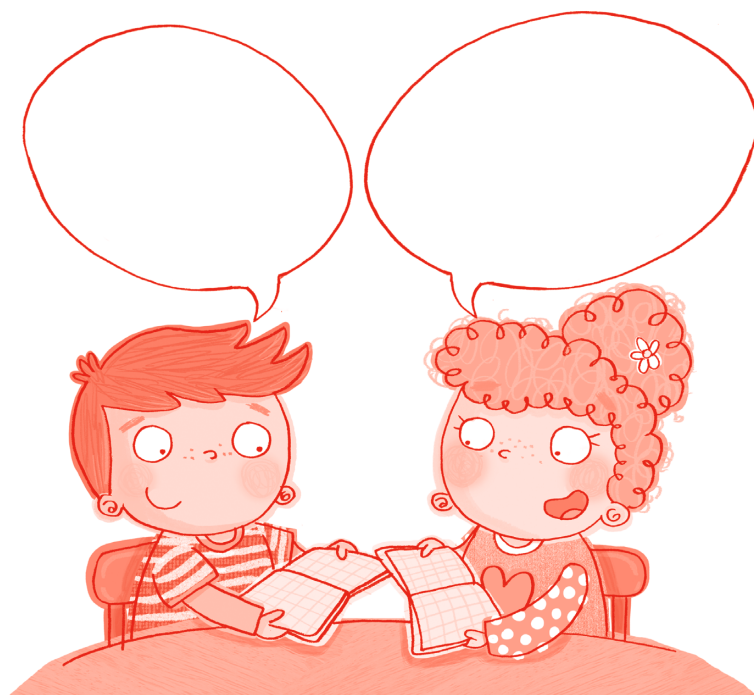


Using Speech to Describe

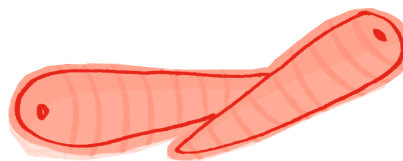
