Goal 4 – Reduce child mortality



4A

Reduce by two-thirds, between 1990 and 2015, the under-5 mortality rate

- 4.1 ▶ Under-5 mortality rate
- 4.2 ▶ Infant mortality rate
- 4.3 ▶ Proportion of 1-year-old children immunized against measles

Goal 5 – Improve maternal health



5A

Reduce by three-quarters, between 1990 and 2015, the maternal mortality ratio

- 5.1 ▶ Maternal mortality ratio
- 5.2 ▶ Proportion of births attended by skilled health personnel

5B

Achieve, by 2015, universal access to reproductive health

- 5.3 ▶ Contraceptive prevalence rate
- 5.4 ▶ Adolescent birth rate
- 5.5 ▶ Antenatal care coverage (at least one visit and at least four visits)
- 5.6 ▶ Unmet need for family planning

Goal 6 – Combat HIV/AIDS, malaria, and other diseases



6A

Have halted by 2015 and begun to reverse the spread of HIV/AIDS

- 6.1 ▶ HIV prevalence among population aged 15–24 years
- 6.2 ▶ Condom use at last high-risk sex
- 6.3 ▶ Proportion of population aged 15–24 years with comprehensive correct knowledge of HIV/AIDS
- 6.4 ▶ Ratio of school attendance of orphans to school attendance of nonorphans aged 10–14 years

6B

Achieve, by 2010, universal access to treatment for HIV/AIDS for all those who need it

- 6.5 ▶ Proportion of population with advanced HIV infection with access to antiretroviral drugs

6C

Have halted by 2015 and begun to reverse the incidence of malaria and other major diseases

- 6.6 ▶ Incidence and death rates associated with malaria
- 6.7 ▶ Proportion of children under-5 sleeping under insecticide-treated bednets
- 6.8 ▶ Proportion of children under-5 with fever who are treated with appropriate anti-malarial drugs
- 6.9 ▶ Incidence, prevalence, and death rates associated with tuberculosis
- 6.10 ▶ Proportion of tuberculosis cases detected and cured under directly observed treatment short course
