# Adding an ebook to your bookshelf

If the book you purchased has an activation code on the inside cover of the book please use the method described below.

### From printed code

1. Next to your name at the top right of the screen there is a 'Redeem' drop down menu.



2. Click on the arrow – this will reveal a text box.

3. Type your Access Code into this box and Click "Activate". (The code can be found on the inside cover of your printed book.)

You should now see your book in "My Bookshelf".
