Remember that a Spanish dictionary has two halves.

Look up **Spanish words** in the **Spanish half**, and **English words** in the **English half**. In the **First Time Spanish Dictionary**, the Spanish side comes first. Sometimes people forget there are two halves to the dictionary and look in the wrong half. When they can't find the word they're looking for, they think it isn't there.

Remember Spanish is at the **front**, English is at the **back**. If you close the dictionary you will see a white line in the middle of the book which divides the two halves.
