Remember that a French dictionary has two halves.

Look up **French words** in the **French half**, and **English words** in the **English half**. In the **First Time French Dictionary**, the French side comes first. Sometimes people forget there are two halves to the dictionary and look in the wrong half. When they can't find the word they're looking for, they think it isn't there.

Remember French is at the **front**, English is at the **back**. If you close the dictionary you will see a blue line in the middle of the book which divides the two halves.
