Notes for parents and teachers

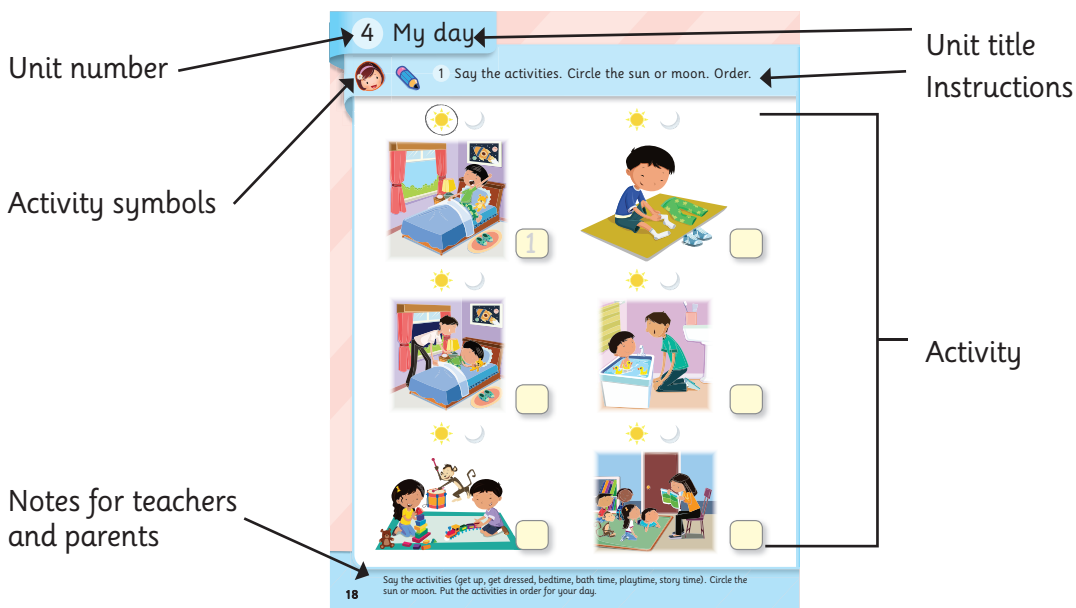
The *First English Words* activity books make learning English possible for very young children. They are full of activities that will encourage children to play and learn whilst having fun.

Activity Book 2 is for 4-5 year-old children. With children of this age, it is important that they enjoy learning and playing with the language. They will not remember all the words immediately, and you should not expect them to. First, they will understand the meaning of the words. Next, they will begin to slowly start saying the words. They will not begin by speaking in sentences – remember this is all about *first words*!

The tasks are slightly more difficult than those in Activity Book 1, and children are sometimes expected to practise writing words. There are many different activities in the book, such as circling, connecting the dots, counting, drawing, colouring, speaking and matching.

Features

The activity books have some important features that help children aged 4–5 when learning. Every page is clearly presented and organised.
