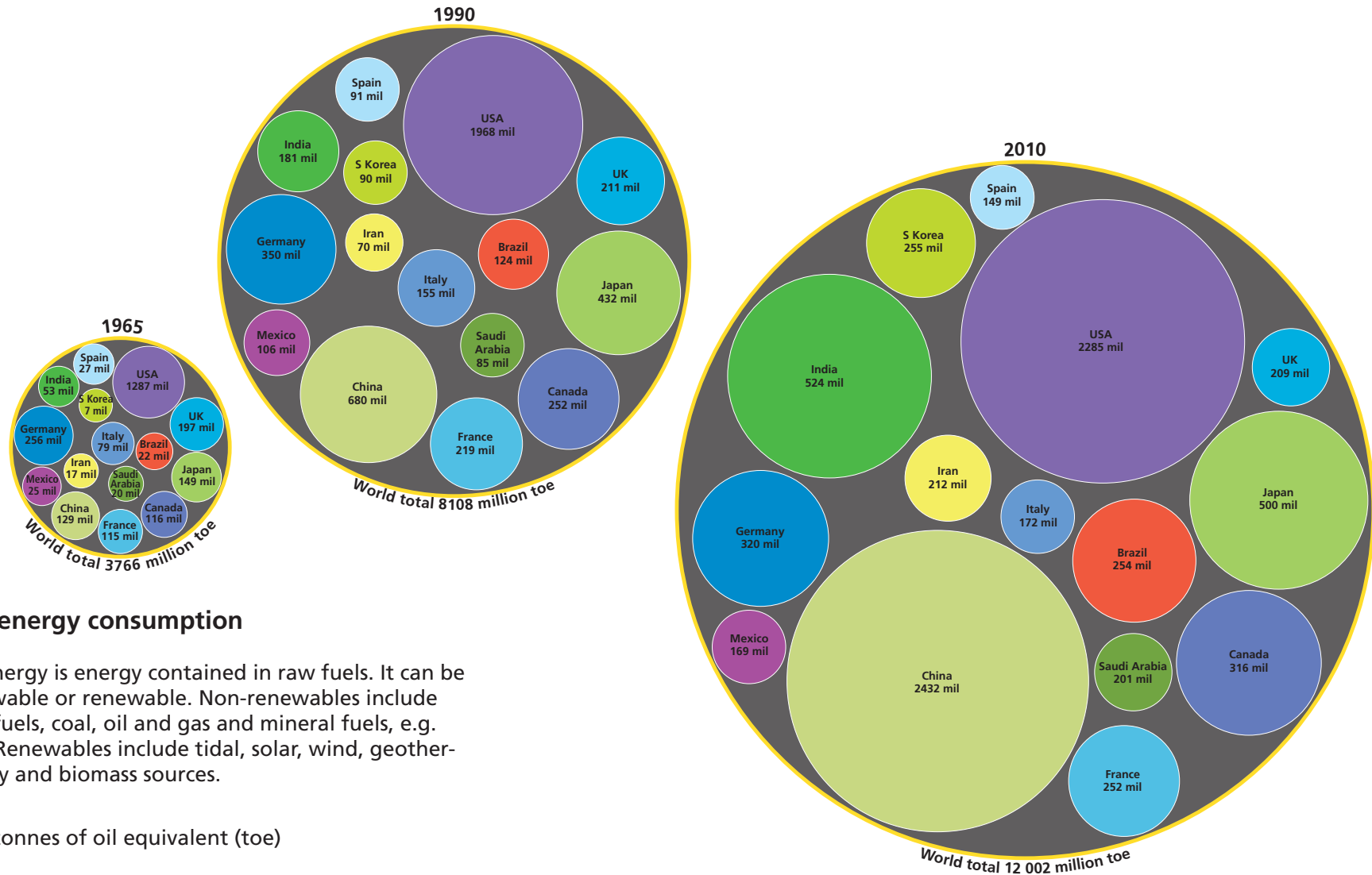


World energy consumption

Primary energy is energy contained in raw fuels. It can be non-renewable or renewable. Non-renewables include the fossil fuels, coal, oil and gas and mineral fuels, e.g. uranium. Renewables include tidal, solar, wind, geothermal energy and biomass sources.
