



How to use this resource

You can use these cards for pairs games:

- 1. Print the complete set of fast words on pages 2–15 onto some card or thick paper.
- 2. Cut out the pairs of cards. You can take out any fast words that the children haven't yet covered.
- 3. Place the remaining cards face down on a table.
- 4. Taking turns, children turn over two cards each.
- 5. Each child reads out the word on each card and when they pick up a pair, they can keep the cards. If they don't pick up a pair, they should place the cards face down on the table where they found them.
- 6. The player with the most pairs wins the game.
