How to use this resource


This reference sheet for children, teaching assistants and teachers can be used in various ways:

- When a child is writing, they can independently double-check a spelling.
- After writing, they can independently check a spelling.
- You can look for a word with the child and call out the letter names as the child writes them: for example, w-a-s = was.
- You can use the sheet as a quick assessment list for reading.

How to use this resource

This reference sheet for children, teaching assistants and teachers can be used in various ways:

- During the early stages of writing, you or your teaching assistant can look with the child to find the sounds they need as they try to sound out along the words.
- When writing independently, the child can find the sounds they need for words, and check how to write them.
- You can use the sheet as a quick assessment list for recognising and saying sounds aloud.
