And lots of them are bugs.

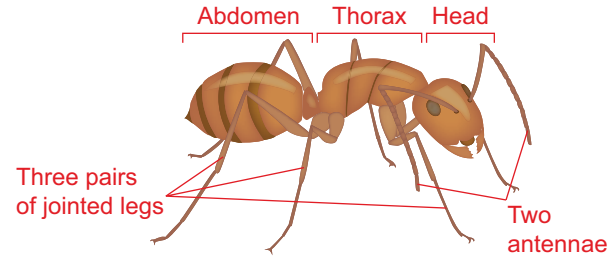

# Scary stingers

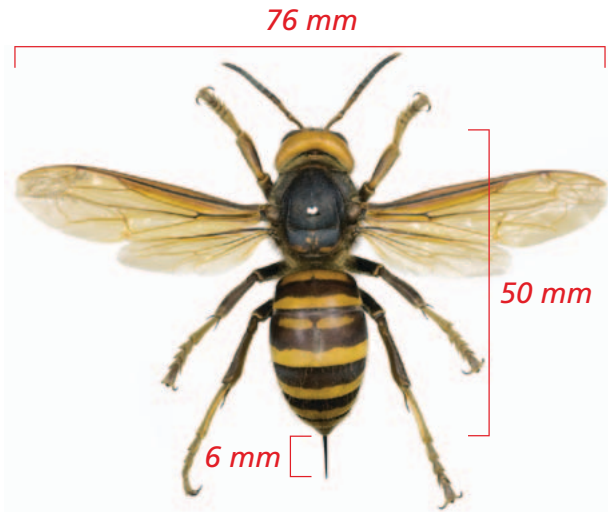


Bees, ants and wasps are all insects that sting.

## Asian giant hornet

Keep out of the way of this guy. In Japan, this bug kills more people than all other creatures put together. And that includes wild bears!

It is about 50 mm long and has a wingspan of 76 mm.



Its stinger is about 6 mm long.

It is found in the parts of the world shown here in orange.



### Did you know?



Probably hundreds of people are killed each year by this bug. Honey bees are its favourite food.
